Update SAT Test Centre at Pearson College UWC

Due to COVID-19 cases increasing in the Province and new B.C. Provincial health-related restrictions and guidelines, **our TEST CENTER at Pearson College UWC will be closed for the December scheduled SAT's tests.**

This applies for Pearson and non-Pearson students registered for SAT tests. All other test centers on Vancouver Island are also closed at this moment.
We are working close with the SAT administration to open our test center next term.

SAT Test Safety Guidelines | Pearson College UWC, Centre 94492

- Arrive to the test center on the main road to drop off the test takers. You will see a sign posted where to drop off test takers.
- We require the **use of masks for all test takers**. Any other PPE (eg. face shields, gloves, etc. are optional)
- Only test takers wearing a mask are allowed to enter the buildings, which is the **Maxbell hall** at Pearson College UWC.
- Entrance will be from **the front of the main building using the stairs**. Signs will be posted to distribute test takers to different waiting rooms and test rooms.
- **Physical distance protocols** will be in place. Please respect them.
- **Washing hands, or using hand sanitizer instead, during all test breaks is required.**
- **Pearson College UWC campus premises are closed to external visitors except for the areas used for testing** during the test times.
- Parents and guardians have to remain inside their cars when dropping off and picking up test takers. They are not allowed to park on the driveways. **In case they wait for their children, they should do it inside their cars for a maximum of 30 minutes before the test has ended.**

Everyone is required to use a mask at all times on College premises.

It is required that test takers follow these procedures. Not following safety guidelines may result in not admitting a test taker.

No external people are allowed to remain at the campus. Please drop off and pickup test takers at the proper times.
