Pearson College UWC is recruiting for an outstanding Dive Instructor for our Diving CAS Program

Reporting to: Deputy Head & Vice President: Education and Learning

Responsibilities include:

- Work with CAS diving students aged 16-19 from around the world to introduce them to underwater life and certify students with PADI open water certification
- Teach scuba diving techniques, first in a pool and later in open water, and continually monitor performance to provide suggestions and feedback as necessary
- Maintain and service dive equipment as necessary
- Maintain records of the dive equipment, air sample tests, and supplies purchased, serviced, damaged, or retired
- Drive Pearson College boat with students to dive sites, and work with Marine Science program for some boat transportation requests
- Work within dive equipment and instruction budget
- Instruct within the hours of our CAS program (Tue, Fri afternoons) and availability for experiential weeks Oct 24-28, 2022 and March 13-March 17, 2023, subject to adaptation as necessary
- Collaborate with faculty lead for reporting, organization, and student communication
